

Step 1 - Create Account: In order to participate live online, you must have a Proxibid live bidding account. Click the following link to create an account: <https://www.proxibid.com/asp/CreateBidder1.asp?>

Step 2 - Auction Registration: You must be registered and approved by the auction company before you can bid. Please allow 24-48 hours to receive bidding approval. Step 3 - Download Java: Proxibid's live Internet bidding service requires Java software. Chances are your computer already has Java software installed, but in the event that you don't have Java installed, you may download it by clicking the following link: <http://jdl.sun.com/webapps/getjava/BrowserRedirect?host=java.com>

Step 4 - Bidding: Once approved to bid, you can place "pre-bids" through Proxibid's website, or you may participate in real-time during the live Interactive auction webcast. The example below shows a screen capture of Proxibid's live bidding application and a brief explanation of its functionality. Once - Twice - Sold Bar: Indicates when the auctioneer is about to close the bidding. We strongly recommend that you place your bids before you see the green "Once" light.

Lot Detail Tab: Will display the complete title, lot description, and up to 6 additional images. More tabs will be displayed when multiple lots are offered as a group.

Lot Selector: Enables you to select the lots from the group that you would like to purchase. Selecting a lot will display the individual purchase price. (See green colored font)

You are only allowed to choose the items you would like to purchase when a *Choice* or *Choice Times the Money Group* have been offered.

All for One and Times the Money groups require that you take all of the items offered by the auctioneer.

The asking price will be multiplied by the number of items selected (See the dark blue "total" box located to the left of the bid button).

Pre-Bid / View: Opens a new window enabling you to place a live pre-bid. Your bid will be automatically represented by the software operator up to your high-bid amount.

Message Center: Shows messages sent from the auctioneer to notify the bidders of important live bidding changes, item description updates, cataloging errors, and more. Registered bidders have the capability to communicate directly with the software operator through the applications' built-in instant chat feature.

Bid Button: Clicking the bid button will submit the amount displayed in the asking price field to the software operator located onsite. The bid button will turn gray and become inactive after your bid has been placed. When you have been out-bid, the button will reactivate so you may place another bid.

Audio-Video Player Button: Launches Proxibid's streaming A/V player, enabling you to see and hear the live auction in progress.

Step 5 - After the Auction: Within 24 hours of the conclusion of an auction, all winning bidders will receive an invoice or "shopping cart" via e-mail indicating the items purchased online. Alternatively, you can login to your "MyProxibid" area to view and print your auction invoice. If you need immediate assistance, contact the auction company or Proxibid customer support.
